- We need to understand any fire and EMS related issues (such as the inability to respond to emergencies) that have developed as issues within your local jurisdiction.
- We need to understand if municipal leaders believe that their constituents would be willing to pay more for enhanced service levels.
- We would like to know if municipal leaders would be willing to support increased funding levels (including possible tax increases) to enhance the current level of fire and EMS services?
- We need to know the thoughts of municipal leaders on alternative systems for providing fire and EMS services moving forward including a more regional or county-based approach.

National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 1710 sets a benchmark for career EMS services for a unit with Basic Life Support (BLS) capabilities to be on the scene of a medical emergency within 6 minutes of receipt of the call in the 9-1-1 dispatch, and a unit with advanced life support (ALS) capability with 10 minutes.

NFPA Standard 1720 for volunteer fire response sets the following response benchmarks for structure fire responses by volunteer fire companies:

- ✓ Urban communities: 15 personnel on scene in 9 minutes (population density > 1,000 per square mile)
- ✓ Suburban communities: 10 personnel on scene in 10 minutes (population density 500 1,000 per square mile)
- ✓ Rural communities: 6 personnel on scene in 14 minutes (population density < 500 per square mile).
